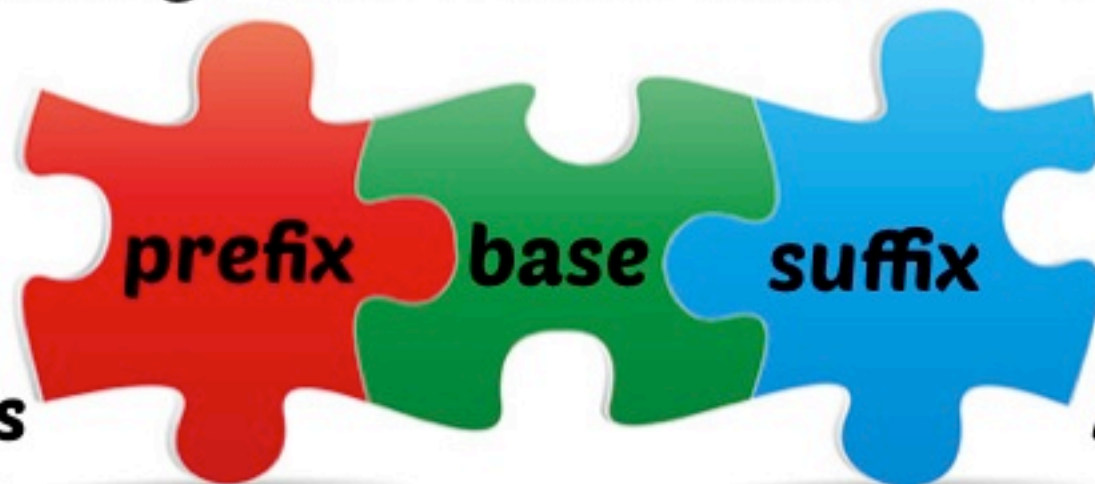




Building Vocabulary

Base: "terr"

A root is a word part that has a specific meaning. There are 3 kinds of roots:



A prefix is added to the front of a base.

A base is the main part of a word.

A suffix is added to the end of a base.

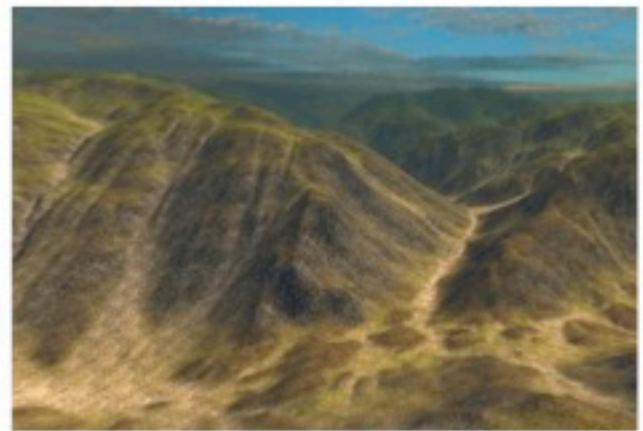

Building Vocabulary

Base: “terr”

The root “terr-” can mean “ground” or “land.”

terrain
“terr” is a prefix

Sometimes “terr” is just a syllable with no meaning.



terrify
“terr” is just a word part

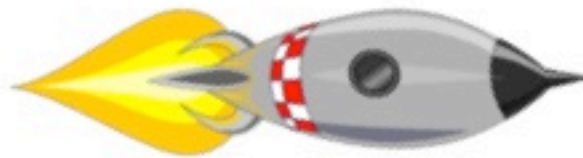
