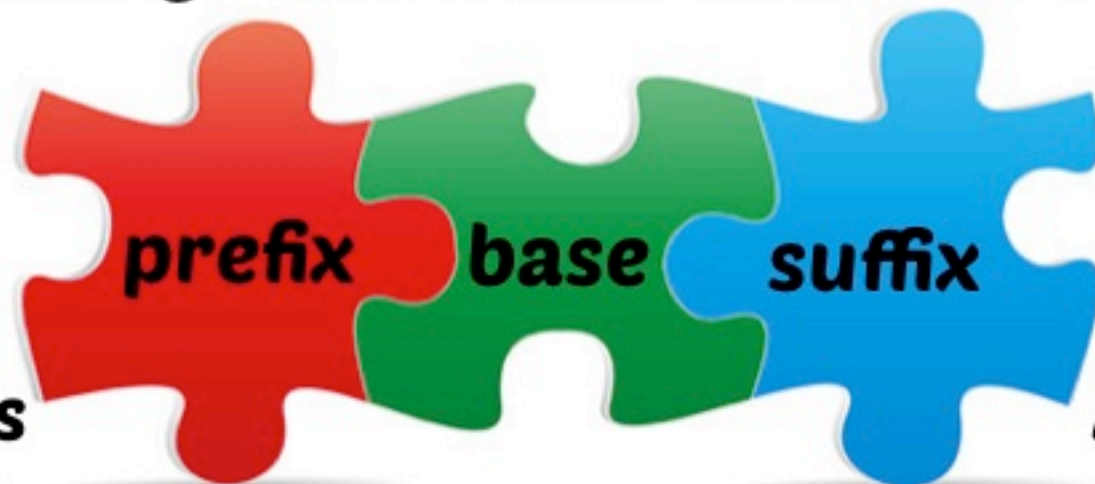




Building Vocabulary

Bases: “voc” & “voke”

A root is a word part that has a specific meaning. There are 3 kinds of roots:



A prefix is added to the front of a base.

A base is the main part of a word.

A suffix is added to the end of a base.

Some people feel that their jobs are “callings”, jobs so important that they have been “called” to perform it. What “voc” word would describe such a job?



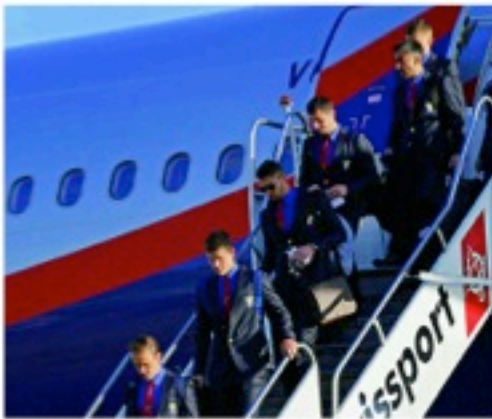

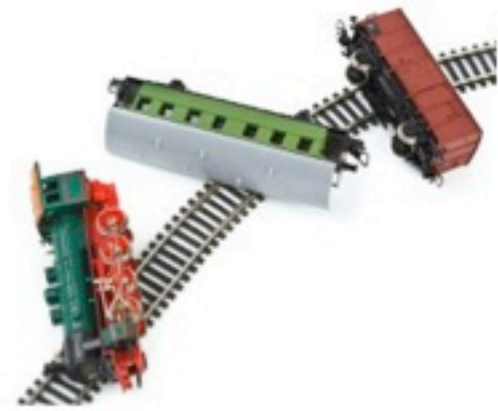

to heat the oven before cooking

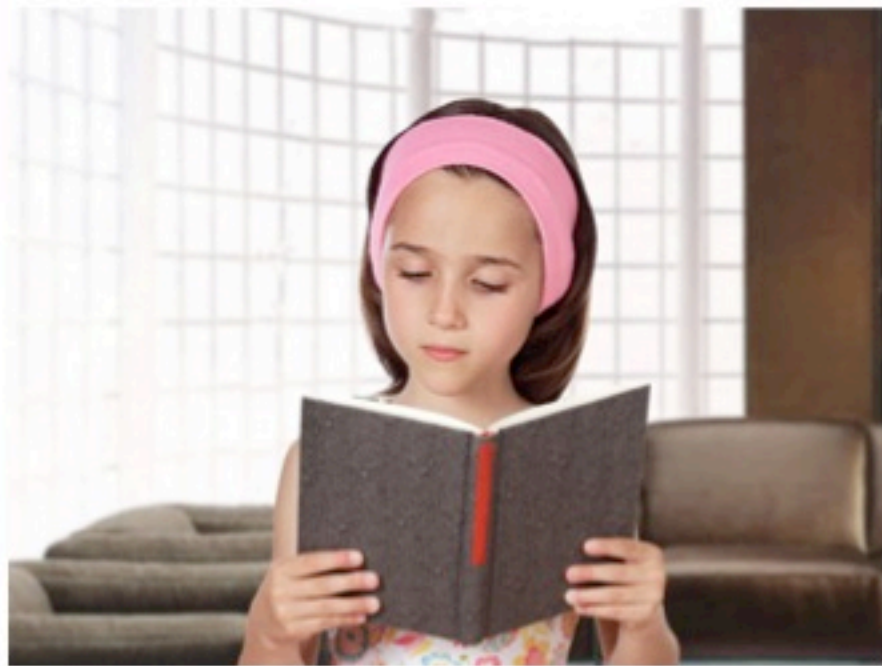
