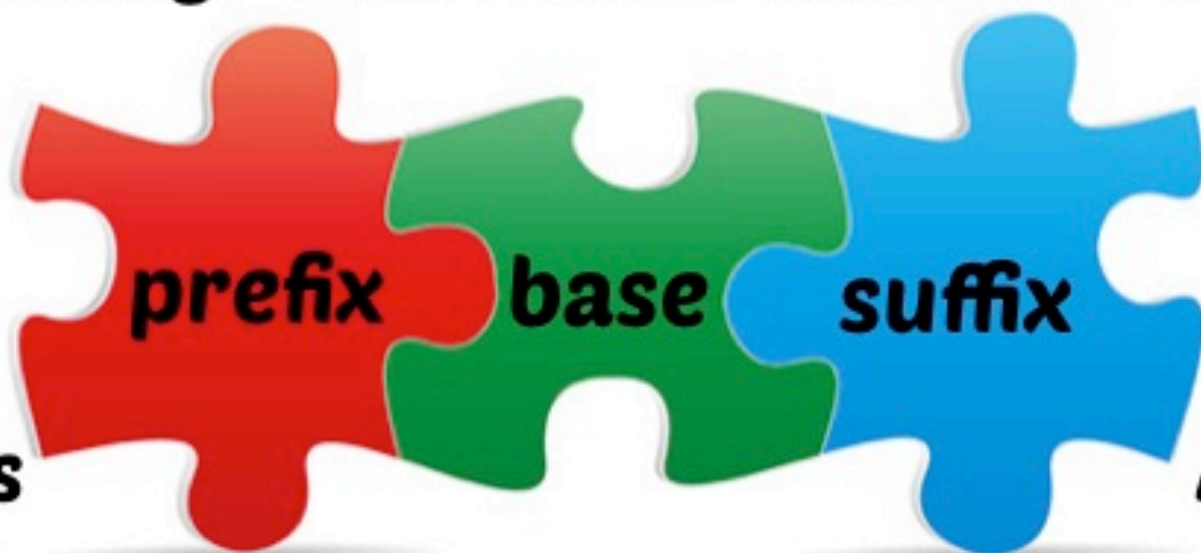




# Building Vocabulary

## Prefix: "inter-"

A root is a word part that has a specific meaning. There are 3 kinds of roots:



A prefix is added to the front of a base.

A base is the main part of a word.

A suffix is added to the end of a base.

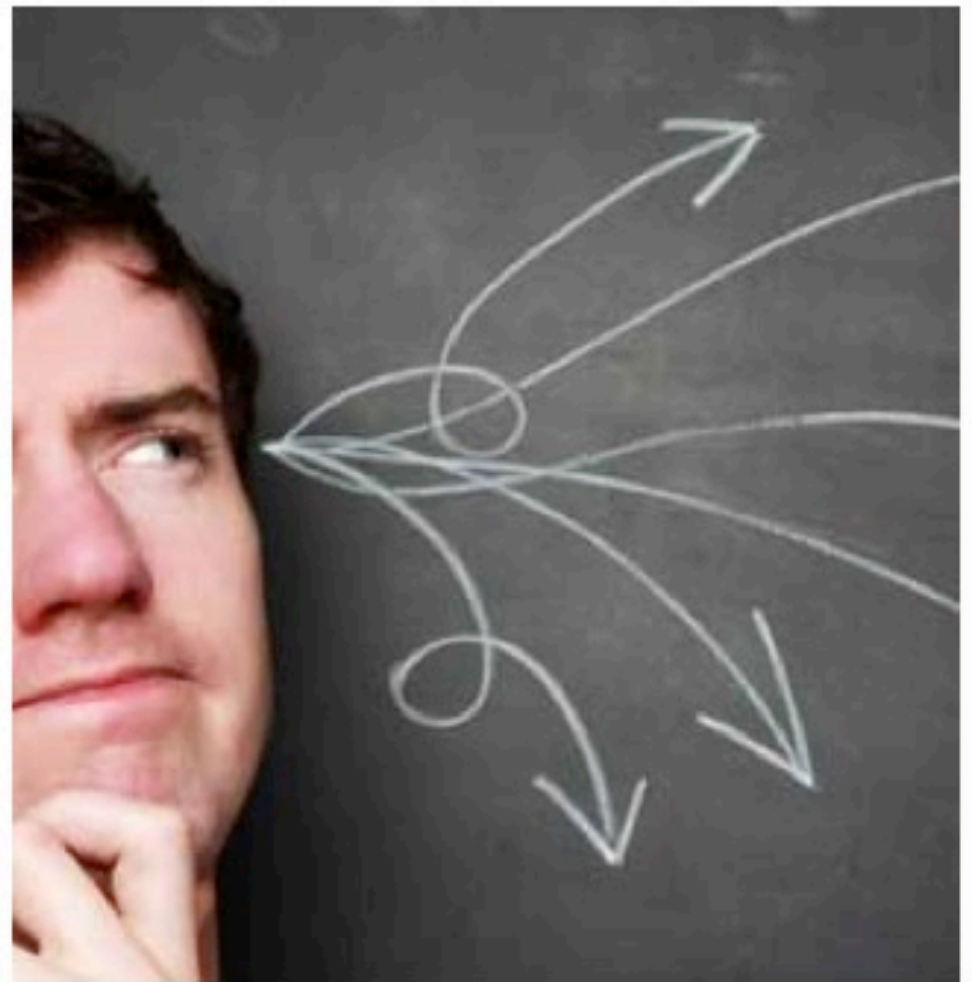

What “inter-” word describes the system or network that allows information to be shared between multiple computers or electronic devices?

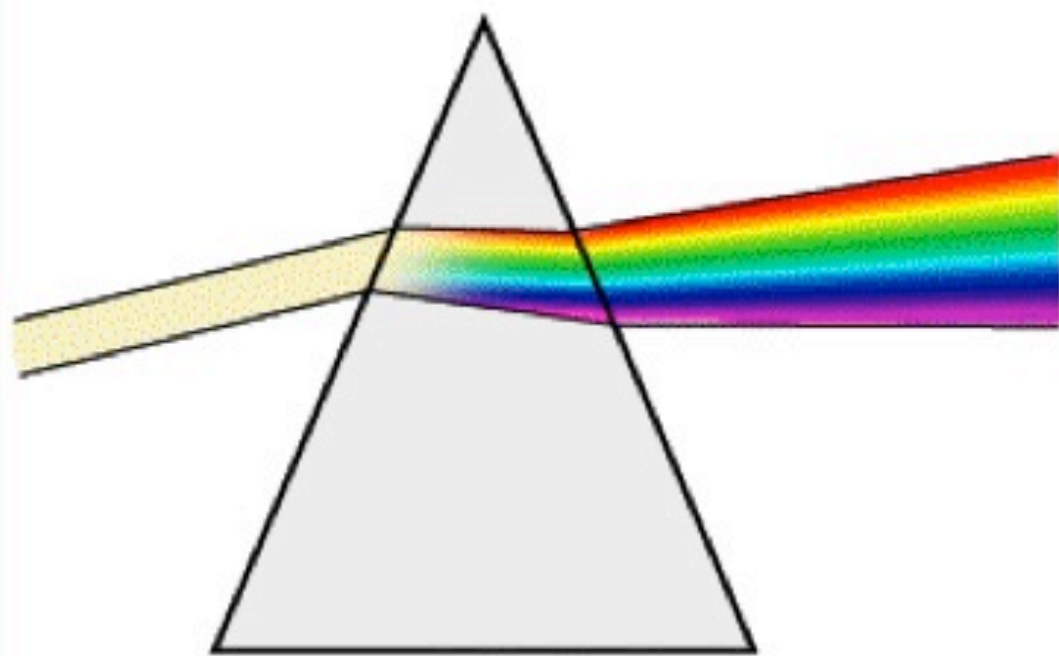

she'd	=	she would

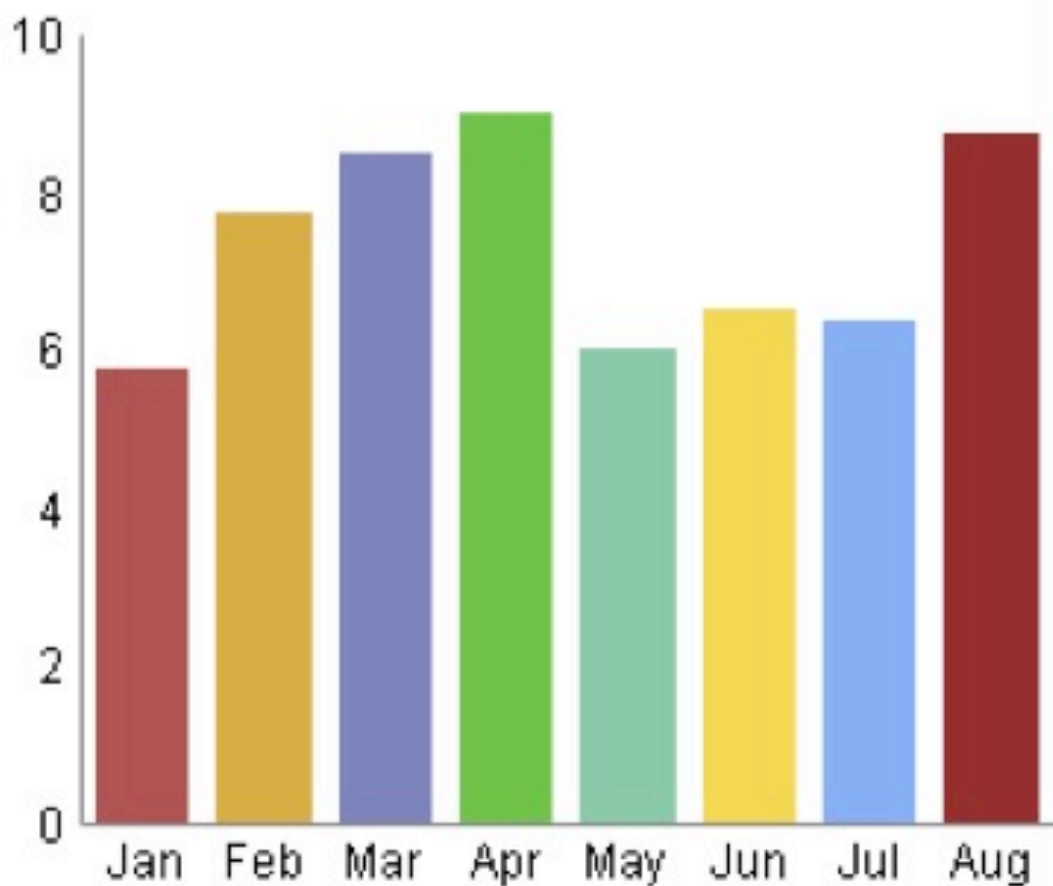

What “voc” word names a person who uses his or her voice to sing a song?



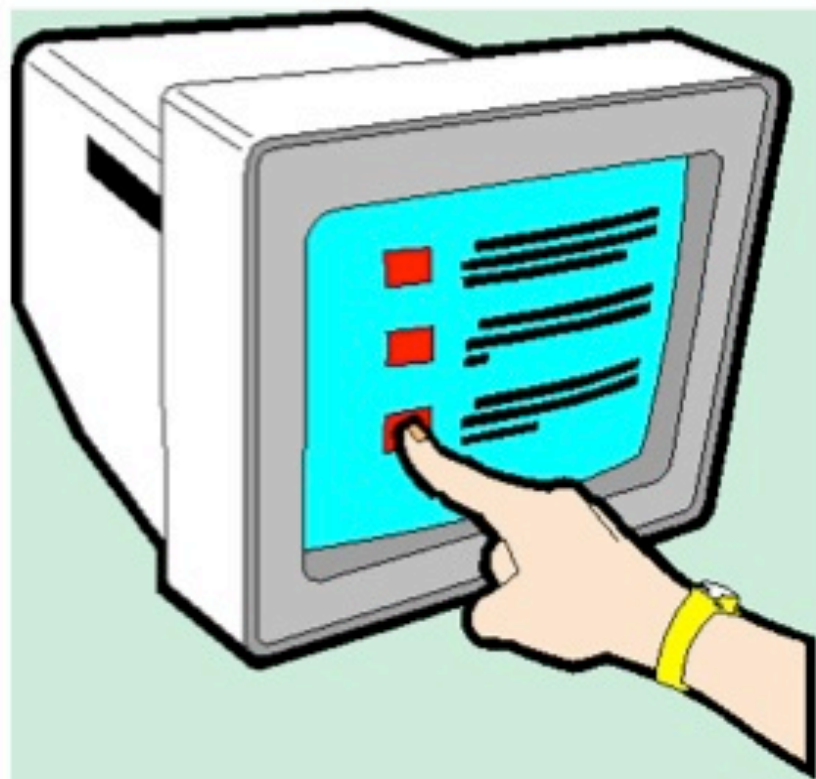
