

A <u>root</u> is a word part that has a specific meaning. There are 3 kinds of roots:

prefix base suffix

A <u>prefix</u> is added to the front of a base.

A <u>base</u> is the main part of a word.

A <u>suffix</u> is added to the end of a base.



The <u>bases</u> "audi" and "audit" can mean "hear" or "listen."




What "audi" word can be used to describe a sound that is so soft that you are <u>not</u> able to <u>hear</u> it?







What "inter-" word describes the system or network that allows information to be shared between multiple computers or electronic devices?








