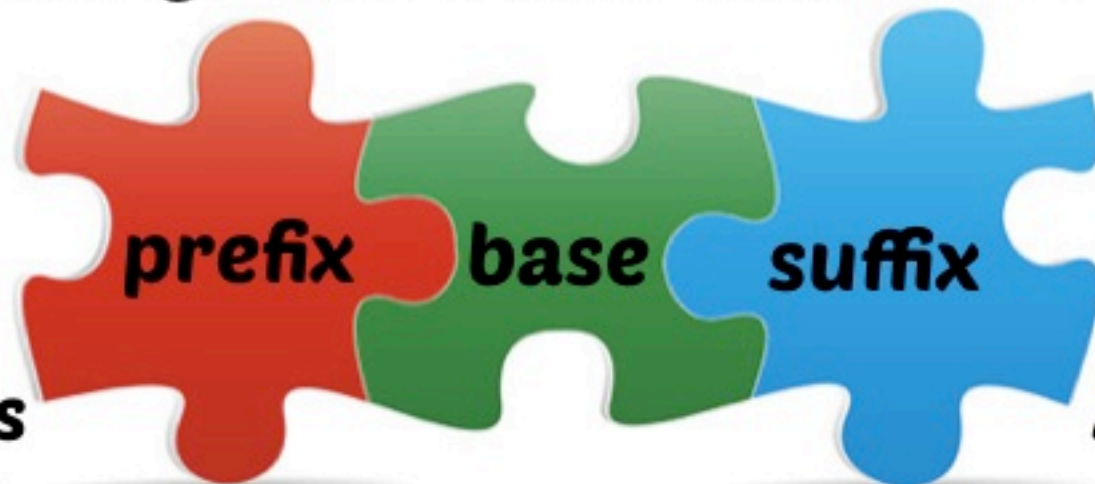




# Building Vocabulary

## Prefix: “pro-”

A root is a word part that has a specific meaning. There are 3 kinds of roots:



A prefix is added to the front of a base.

A base is the main part of a word.

A suffix is added to the end of a base.

# Building Vocabulary Roots & Their Meanings

The roots “il-”, “im-”, and “in-” are prefixes that share the same meaning: “not or the opposite of.”

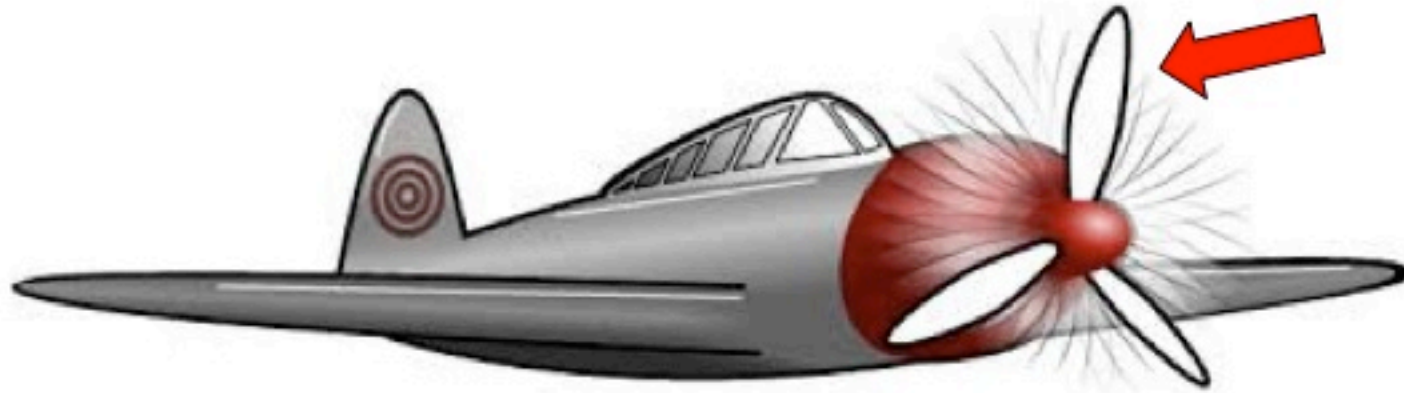

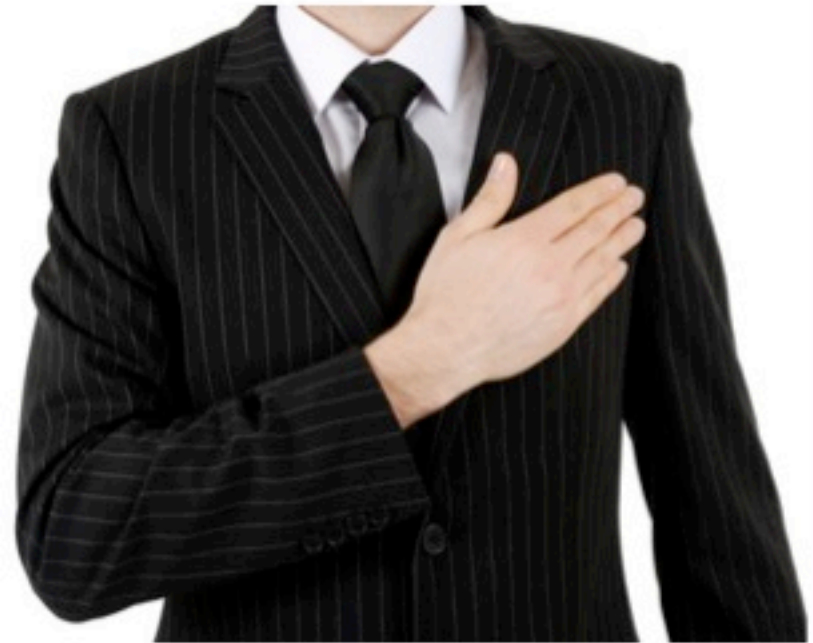

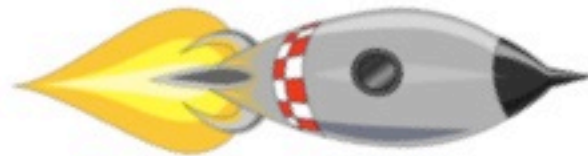

**What “com-” word can be used to name an organization in which people work together, usually for the purpose of making money?**





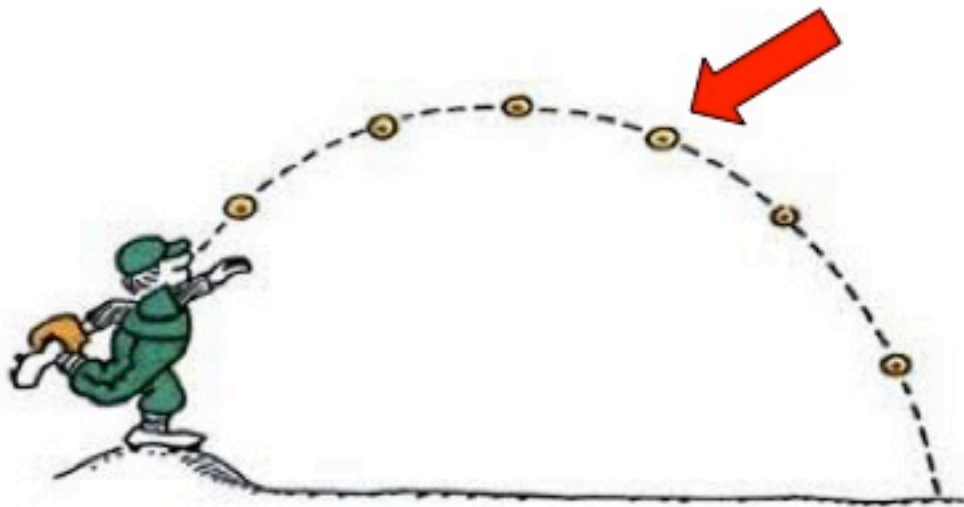

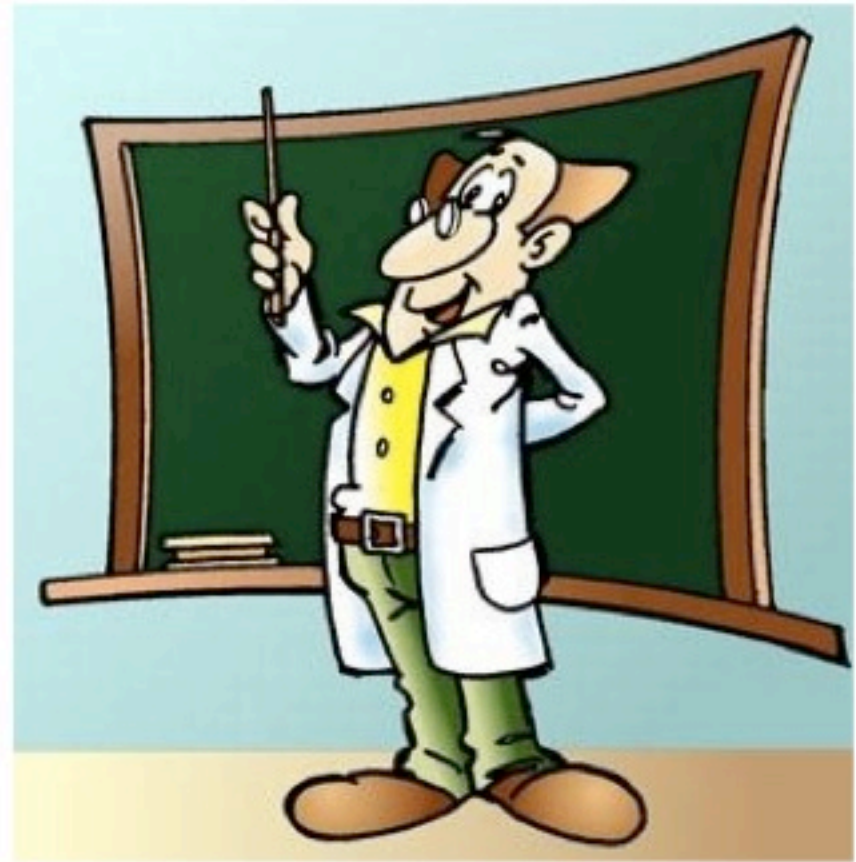

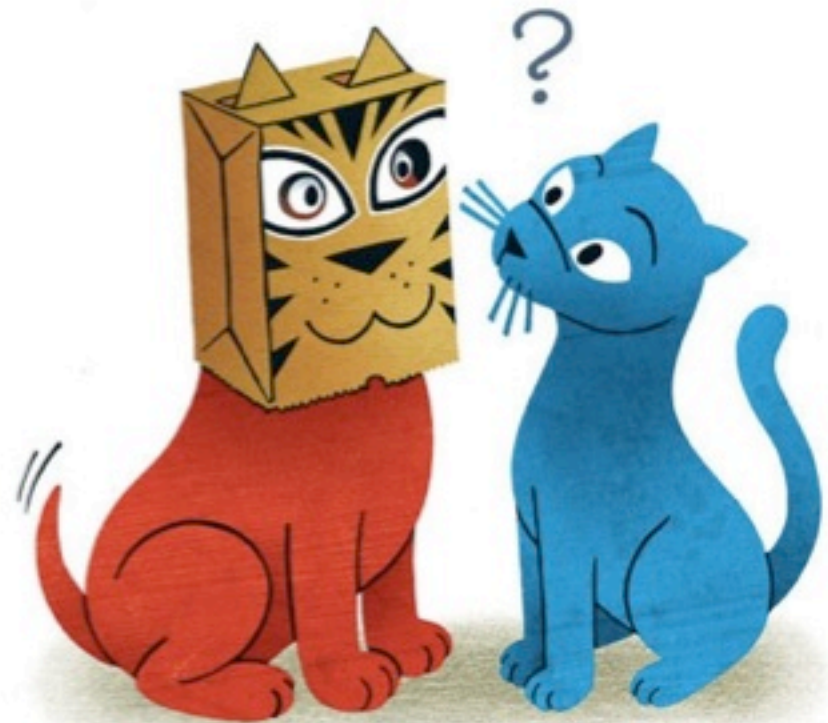


# Building Vocabulary

What “pro-” word describes the act of helping an idea, action, business move forward by encouraging positive feelings in others.

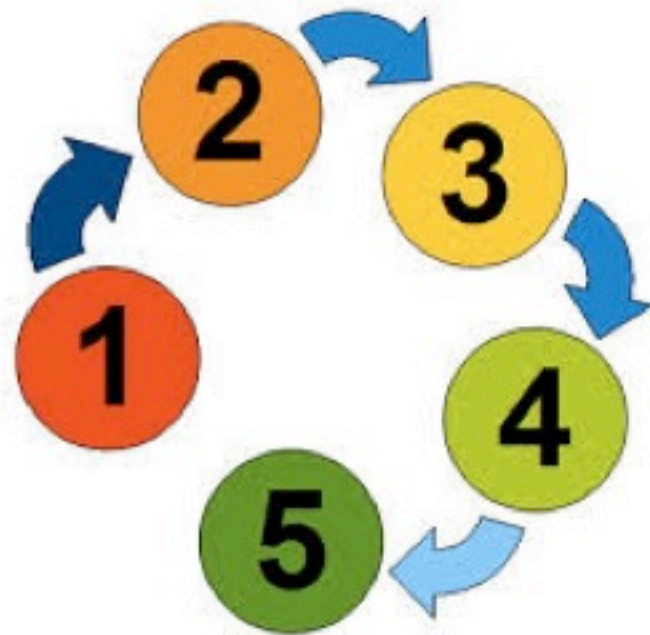
